1. Please contact ETMM Trip Director to obtain reservation request forms for all trips. Please let ETMM Trip Director know if you made Steamboat reservations so that we know how many Mogul Mashers are on each trip and we can lodge together. Big Sky & Keystone reservations and payments must go to ETMM Trip Director.

2. Payment: Appropriate deposit must accompany all reservation forms and be turned into ETMM Trip Director. Deposits and payment schedules are outlined for each trip.

3. Changes & Cancellations: All requests for changes, cancellations, or refunds must be made in writing. Penalties and Cancellation forfeitures will be as described under each trip.

4. **All participants on Crescent sponsored trips must be members of an authorized club.** Current membership is required to sign up for a trip. If a trip is planned for the next ski season/fiscal year, membership will have to be renewed before airline and/or lift tickets will be distributed.

Steamboat – December 6-13, 2008

25th ANNIVERSARY - STEAMBOAT RACE & SKI CAMP - 2008

SIGN-UP PERIOD: Sign-up period begins **April 25, 2008** and ends **November 17, 2008, or when 400 are reached** whichever comes first.

TRIP DATES: December 6-13, 2008

PACKAGE COST (VARIES): **\$840 is the "base" rate in a 3B/3B unit**, which is limited in quantity (usually about 120 spaces). Other rates/options are available (see Lisa B for full pricing and reservation forms). Plus transfers and air.

WHAT'S INCLUDED:

- 7 nights lodging at The Lodge @ Steamboat
- 6 day lift ticket
- 5 full days of lessons (may be deducted options)
- 3 Lunches (M-W-F) – **all participants with lift ticket**
- Welcome Wine & Cheese
- Keg Party
- Western BBQ Dinner
- Awards Dinner and Door Prizes
- NASTAR Race or "CSC Format" Race (**can NOT do both**)
- Free shuttle bus service within Steamboat (includes downtown)

WHAT'S NOT INCLUDED:

- 3% Credit Card Payment add-on (if CC is used)
- Air Fare (SAT will handle for you if you wish)
- Ground Transportation (SAT has bus & rental car options)
- Other meals not specifically listed.
- Equipment rentals (Special Crescent discount)

PAYMENTS/CHANGES/CANCELLATIONS: A deposit of \$200.00 is due at sign-up. An interim payment of \$300.00 will be due at the July meeting. Final payment will be due at the September meeting. Failure to make proper payments by the due dates will automatically be considered a request to cancel and the stated cancellation policy will apply. All returned checks are subject to a \$25.00 service charge.

UPDATE: The trip will be capped at 400. A third of the trip is already booked. There are only 11 pillows at the 3bedroom\3bath, lowest price rate left. Sports America is holding ETMM group air from Tri Cities to Denver for \$580. We need 10 to get this price, or it will go up significantly. To date I have 3 signed up that would use this air. I will have to drop this space after the July meeting, so if you are planning to go, now is the time to sign up!
